

Even the acclaimed American film director John Ford couldn't have scouted a more dramatic locationfor the gritty tale of Chevrolet's fleeting, epic saga of one Impala, one woman, and the hardscrabble
gang that came together as a family to protect them both from the relentless dangers of earth and sky.

Precariously balanced on a wind-blown, spindly column of rock, they battled the forces of nature in the
Great American West—then the actress blew the audience a kiss and waved goodbye. Superimpose
logo. The end.

Decades earlier, John Ford chose pretty much the same area for any number of his gripping westerns. His award-winning cinematography and dramatic storytelling in movies like *Fort Apache*, *The Searchers, She Wore a Yellow Ribbon*, and *Stagecoach* demanded majestic, stark, windswept scenery— but also relative proximity to the movie industry's home base in Hollywood, California. He regularly chose tribal, state, and national parks in and around southern Utah to properly frame his A-list cast members, which included John Wayne, Natalie Wood, Henry Fonda, Maureen O'Hara, and James Stewart. Chevrolet swaggered up to Castleton Tower (aka Castle Rock) armed with an ad budget that only the single largest GM division could justify. The original ad featured a red 1964 Impala convertible, relieved of its heavier (and unseen) components, cut into several pieces, airlifted by helicopter, and reassembled atop the sandstone tower. The model was plopped into the car and filming began. As soon as the winds permitted, the process was reversed.

A corresponding "The Chevrolet Way" print ad was released in early 1966, just to remind folks that the Chevrolet Division was still in the game, with total sales to date of 23-million vehicles. In 1973, Impala fans braced themselves for *Acrophobia II*, as a blue hardtop reprised the original act with a new actress, but incorporated the same basic workflow and team effort.
