## February 1st, 2020

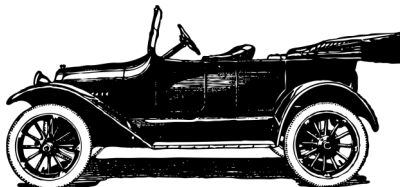
- >Meeting called to order at 2 PM

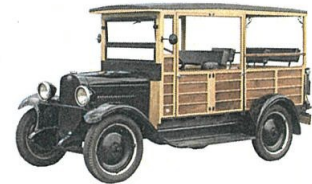
