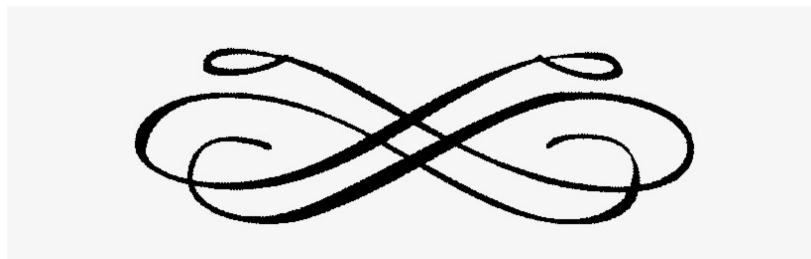

- > Money can’t buy happiness, but it sure keeps the kids in touch.....

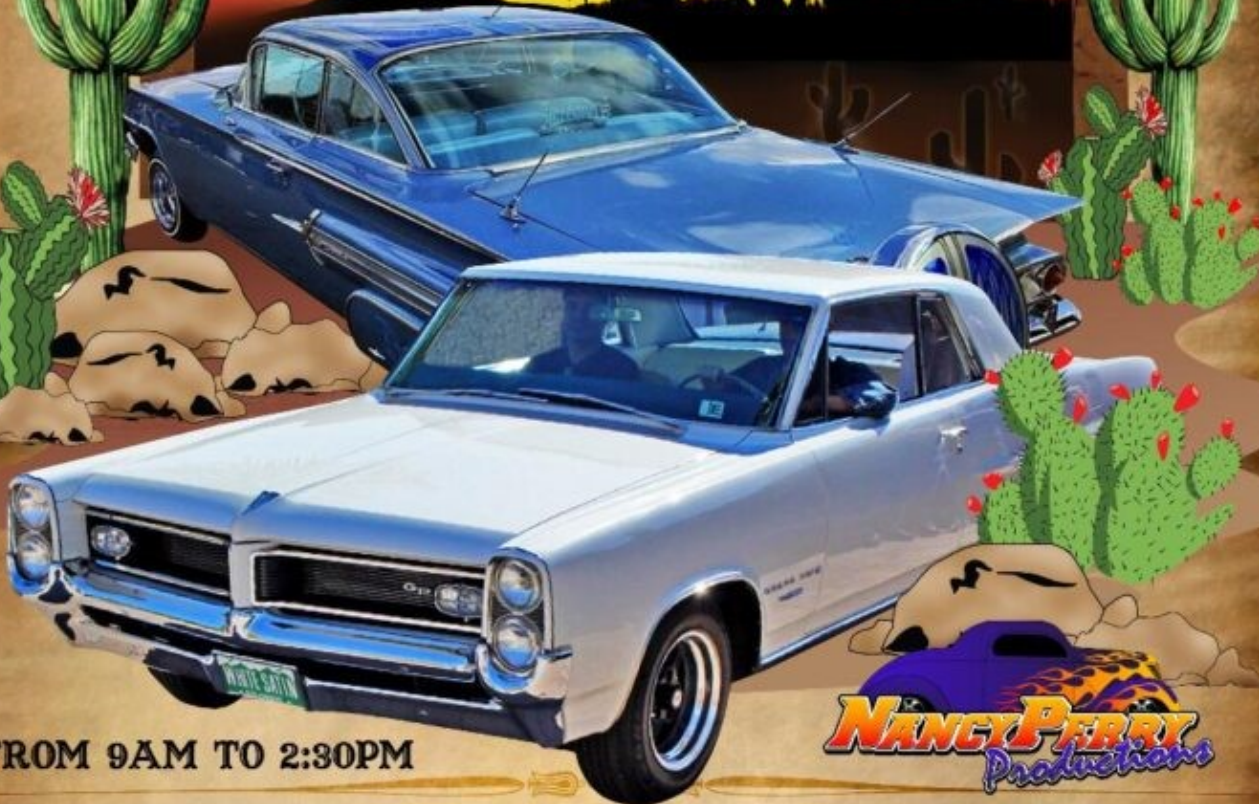
