

PLEASE PLAN TO ARRIVE BY 9:45

Detailed instructions: The address is 8618 E. Los Gatos Drive, Scottsdale. There is a light at Los Gatos Dr on Pima Rd; turn west on Los Gatos off Pima and enter the gate. Jim Grose will open gate. Once thru the gates, continue driving west on Los Gatos Drive to the second house on the right, <u>past</u> the community mail boxes. "8618" is on our brick light posts by driveways.

Go to the second set of light posts (the second driveway) and then

drive north to the very back of the property. There is room for 30-40 cars in the back and has ample lighting.

Please park in the back of the property by the collection building. There is room for 30-40 cars on decomposed granite and is well lit. You may also park on the circle driveway, in front of the house, if you prefer to make the long walk back. The HOA does not allow parking on the street. Please, park facing straight into the perimeter walls; either facing north on the decomposed granite or facing south on the concrete. We will make a third row in the middle at the end. **See picture.**


Following this, several of the group motored over to Carlos O'Brien's for some tasty Mexican food and as always, car talk. A good time was had by all!
